



# Greetings from Dundee! It's bottling season!


## At The Four Graces there is a particular satisfaction that comes when we finally

The idea of bottling is certain to increase the heart rate of most winemakers. In the weeks leading up to bottling, we quiet our artistic mindset to focus on the

science of winemaking. Bottling requires close attention to technical details, like temperature, dissolved oxygen, labels, cork moisture...the list goes on. Bottling is where all the components of wine come together into a final package. The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Foley Family Estate Vineyard that encompasses 110 acres nestled in the Red Hills of Dundee as well as our newest vineyard, Black Walnut Estate. The pinot noir for this rosé was handpicked and

#### contribution from the neutral French oak adds weight and length to the palate and also allows contact with the lees for a creamy texture. Aromas of fresh wild strawberry and stone fruits set the tone for this delightful rosé. The palate shows



2021 Estate Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir The Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir is the result of ongoing observation in the vineyard to select the best fruit from specific rows and blocks. The Foley Family Estate Vineyard which produces this wine boasts the jory soils well known for their iron-rich, fertile characteristics. Our 2021 Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir displays a dark ruby color. Nuanced aromas of dark cherries, spice and mulberry set the tone. Juicy black cherry coats the palate with notes of vanilla

and spice highlighted in the background. The use of new French oak barrels in this wine supports the fruit and adds a touch of baking spice aroma where the contribution of older French oak barrels allows the tannins to develop gracefully

over time. The finish is silky and long, which is a characteristic of Dundee Hills Pinot Noir.
