2022 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT GRIS

Our 2022 pinot gris was sourced from our estate vineyards in the Van Duzer Corridor and the Dundee Hills AVA's, as well as Goschie Vineyard near Silverton, Oregon. This pinot gris has beautiful aromas of stone fruit in the glass with a hint of struck flint. The palate continues in this medium-bodied wine with fresh pear, apple and stone fruit, which leads into a vibrant lingering acidity.

2021 "HIGHGROUND" YAMHILL-CARLTON PINOT NOIR

Our "Highground" is named for the location of where the grapes for this wine are grown at the very top of our Doe Ridge Estate vineyards in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. These topmost vines are grown in a unique "diagonal" row orientation to capture the most sunlight every day. The 2021 Highground Pinot Noir is vibrant and deep ruby in color. On the nose, aromas of blackberries and cassis are complemented by hints of orange peel and cedar. The palate delivers a smooth texture and layers of baked cherries and black tea. This dense and complex wine with full structure and powerful tannins is reflective of the characteristics of pinot noir grown in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA..
